

ROVER RESCUE UPDATE

The Rover Rescue group within the HBRO is in the process of re-structuring in order to draw in those who have expressed an interest in the service and to better present the group to the emergency services.

Once responsibilities have been apportioned and basic training schedules set up, there will be a regular pub meet at a central location, which will be publicised in forthcoming issues of Pants and Barks open to anybody interested in the group. The format will be different to a normal pub meet in that it will be structured with a clear objective in mind. The noggin bit will of course remain, but as far as nattering goes, this will be restricted to a quite specific subject.

The group still needs to hear from those people who have particular skills or facilities that could benefit the group without necessarily wishing to be intimately involved. These would include electronic repair facilities, chain saw loan and training, generator loan, although we have one already, albeit a horribly noisy specimen and any other skill or facility that could usefully be offered to and used by the group.

Video Review.

I was recently sent a copy of the Video Off Road Guide from PP Video Productions which I feel is worthy of mention in these pages, so here it comes.

The Video is approximately 50 minutes long and divided into 7 major sections, each of which is intended to be informative in nature; the overall aim of the video being to instruct the 4x4 driver about Off Road techniques and equipment. This it does admirably, and if I were a newcomer to the hobby I would go as far as to say that the video is almost essential viewing. However since you are reading this in a Land Rover club newsletter you probably don't consider yourselves novices with 4x4s; but make no mistake you will still find the subject matter interesting and well presented, and you may still learn something. Even if you are the club expert then the action footage should still be entertaining.

The major sections are listed below:

- ⊗ Driving Techniques, Part 1
- ⊗ Tyre Selection
- ⊗ Power to the Wheels
- ⊗ Driving Techniques, Part 2
- ⊗ Vehicle Recovery
- ⊗ Competitions.

Having watched the video the complete, a novice to 4x4s should be armed with enough information to help him choose a vehicle type, equip it for his needs, and then to drive it in a competent fashion over most types of terrain. Of course, having been shown how to do things properly you can then watch the Competitions section to see which advice the competitors heed, and what they ignore!

Take my advice and buy a copy, I don't think that you will be disappointed and the distributors offer a money back guarantee anyway.


Lend a Helping Hand


RTV and CCVT Trial at SLAB


